It is our policy to give Environmental issues the highest priority. As a minimum standard, in accordance with our ISO14001 accredited systems, we will undertake works strictly in accordance with the provisions of all current and applicable legal and regulatory requirements as well as other requirements to which Brown & Mason Group Limited subscribes. Our aim is to ensure, so far as it is reasonably practical, that the environment is not exposed to potential harm as a result of our undertakings.

The Company acknowledges the interface between demolition/asbestos removal operations and the environment and strives to attain and preserve the highest standards of environmental care in accordance with, and with full regard to all relevant requirements, imposed or voluntarily subscribed, including the Environmental Protection Act 1990.

We are committed to the continual improvement of our environmental performance, not just limited to the prevention of pollution where ever practicable but also to minimising our ecological impact and the potential to affect biodiversity. In our decision making we will take due cognisance of the environmental impact of our activities.

We will:

- Promote the safe implementation of demolition and asbestos removal techniques.

- Utilise techniques to reduce the environmental impact of current and future intended activities.
- Plan and implement our work with due cognisance of and respect for local biodiversity.
- Determine our strategies for compliance to both local and national ecological constraints.

- Reduce the amount and environmental impact of waste generated through waste minimisation with emphasis on re-use and recycling following the Waste Minimisation Hierarchy:
